Accommodation: There is a spacious and welcoming entrance hall which leads into the bright double aspect living room which has a feature fireplace and also opens to an extended dining room and in turn the kitchen which houses the gas boiler for the central heating. There is a superb newly built garden/family room overlooking the garden and this has a radiator so is useable all year round. There are two very spacious bedrooms, each with ensuite one a bathroom and one a shower room, and the former is in fact a 'Jack and Jill' bathroom accessed off the hallway as well.

Outside: The bungalow sits on a wonderful plot with an attractive mainly lawned gardens to the front and rear. The paved drive gives good off road parking and leads to the detached garage which measures 20'6 x 10'8 and has a useful workshop area to the rear. The back garden is a particularly lovely feature being secluded and there is also a shed, various shrubs and a paved patio.
